And he lived as a Prince indeed.

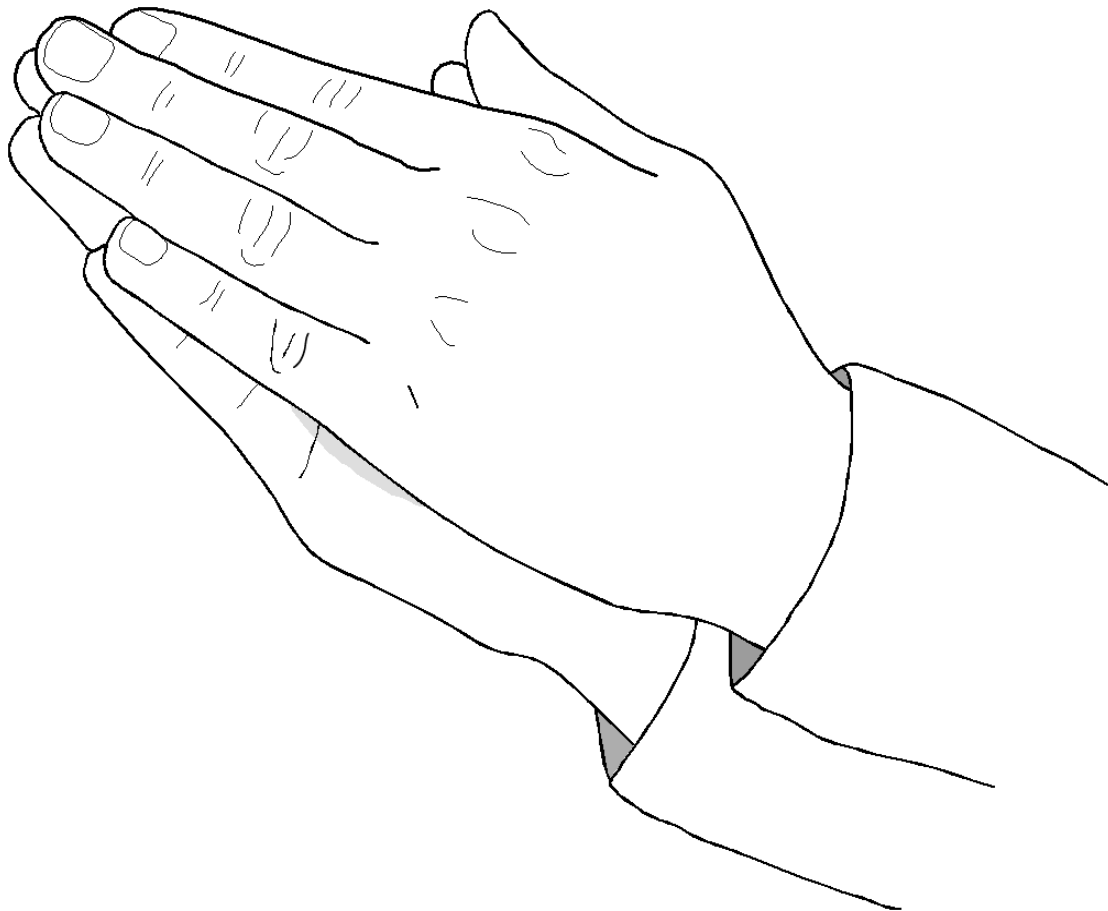


One day Moses noticed that he was much like a Jew.

Moses went to Pharaoh to ask for his people's freedom.

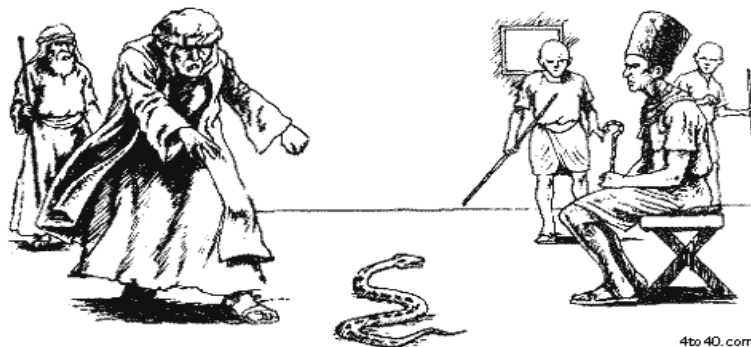
Pharaoh laughed and said, "No way! No out you go."

Do not steal

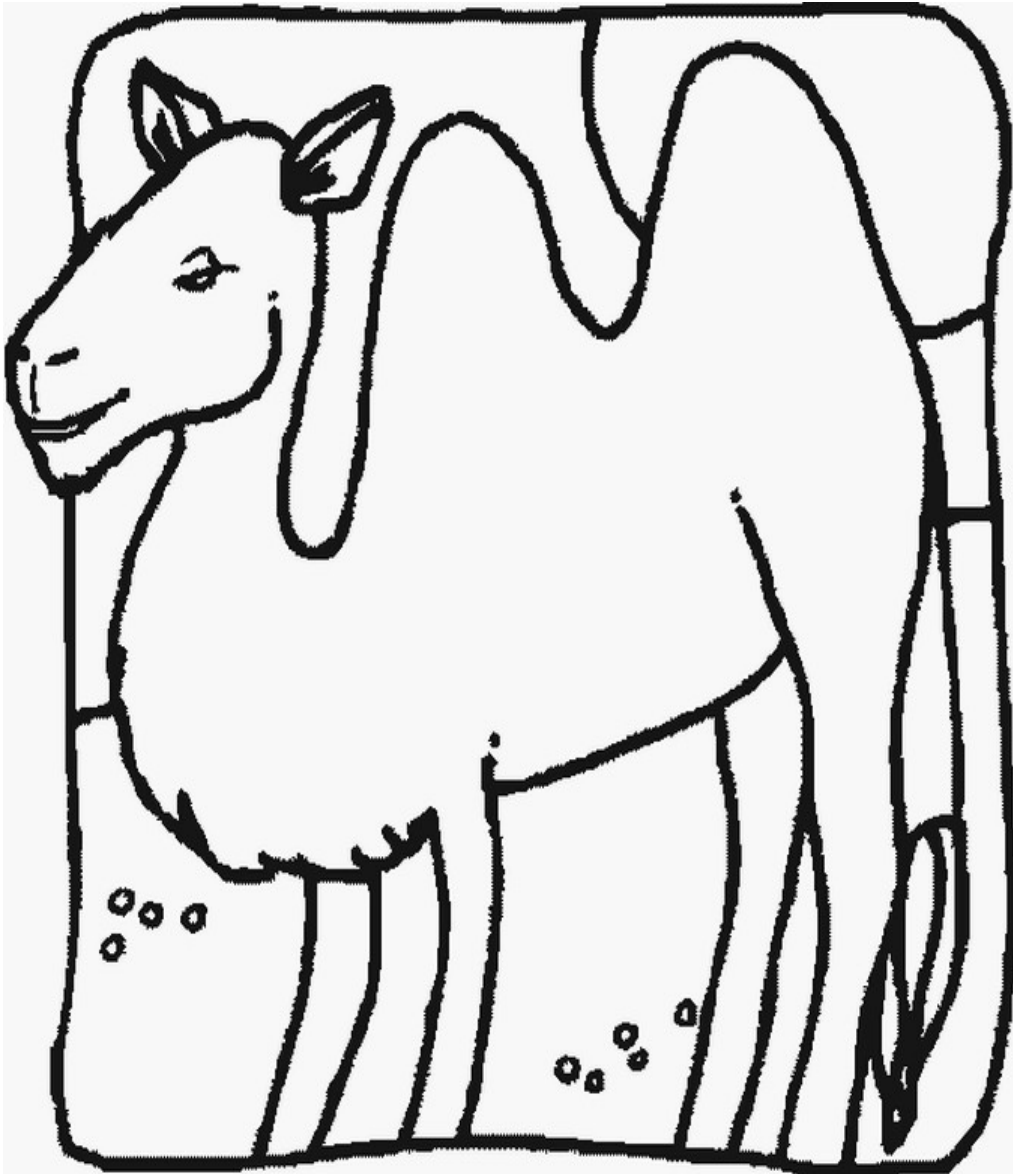
Do not lie (give false testimony)
